Wittke Announces Campaign for Re-election

Racine, WI – Today, State Representative Robert Wittke announced he will be seeking re-election to the **new 63rd Assembly District**.

“I’m honored to have served the constituents of the 62nd Assembly District for the last six years. Though the district has changed, I look forward to continuing to serve the residents of the Villages of Caledonia and Raymond, and soon the City of Franklin,” said Wittke.

Wittke was first elected to represent the 62nd Assembly District in 2018, succeeding Rep. Tom Weatherston, and he has worked to be a strong leader on education, taxation, and economic development for Racine County and Wisconsin. In the 2023-2024 Legislative Session, Wittke serves as Co-chair of the Joint Legislative Audit Committee where he has worked to provide oversight of state government agency operation and use of taxpayer dollars.
